A RIM Shoe looks like a standard shoe but has a groove through the middle. What is this groove for? - traction

A HEART Bar shoe has an extra pointed piece in the center. What is this for? - Frog support

BAR shoes form a completely closed shoe – the bar refers to the closure in the back of the shoe. What is this for? – heel support

An EGG Bar is a type of BAR shoe but forms an oval and extends beyond the heel. Why? More support for the heel and leg.
