

# Foxhunting Match Game II (38 cards)

Note: This is the same as the Foxhunting Match Game I except there are 38 matches rather than 15. I use this version when I want the participants to interact. Hand each participant several cards from set A and set B. Instruct them to interact and swap cards with others to end up with properly matched sets.

This is just a simple match game whereby the member will match cards of one color to cards of another color. On each card is printed some aspect of foxhunting and will have a corresponding mate. For example the card reading "Tally Ho" needs to be matched with it's mate reading "You see a fox". The answer key is listed below.

There are two lists of cards on the following pages. It is best to print the two sets on card or cover stock paper so it is easier to handle and will last for more than one class/person. It is also a good idea to print the two sets on different color paper, but this is just a visual issue - it is not critical because every card in the first set has an "A" in the corner, and the second set has a "B" in the corner. Different colors and the A and B are used so the student knows he/she is matching one card from one set to a card from the other set.

The last page is a list of categories. Since there are so many cards, you may want to put them in piles under the proper category.

Use this *after* reviewing foxhunting as a game to practice what they have just learned.
