<p>The other non-staff riders on the hunt. They stay close behind the Field Master - THE FIELD</p>	<p>Oversees the care and training of the hounds - HUNTSMAN</p>
<p>The leader of the Hunt. Responsible for all hounds, Riders, and staff. - MFH</p>	<p>Very good riders, ride on the outside of the hounds and field riders. Round up stray hounds and riders. - WHIPPER-IN</p>
<p>The tail of the hound - STERN</p>	<p>A pair of hounds - COUPLE</p>
<p>When baby hounds are born - WELPING</p>	<p>The group of hounds that will be hunting that day - PACK</p>
<p>The sound made by a hound when picking up a scent - SPEAK</p>	<p>When hounds search for a lost scent - CAST</p>
<p>When hounds hunt an animal other than a fox - RIOT</p>	<p>Like a foxhunt, but follow an artificial scent laid down by humans - DRAG HUNT</p>
<p>The time and place of the hunt - FIXTURE</p>	<p>When a fox escapes the hounds into an earthen hole - GONE TO GROUND</p>
<p>When the hounds run past a change in the scent line - OVERRUN</p>	<p>A hound who 'gives tongue' to every scent. A bad fault in a hound. - BABBLER</p>

Spring & Summer - when new 'cub' hounds are taken out for training. - CUBBING SEASON	November to March - the formal foxhunting months - HUNT SEASON
When the terrain is so overgrown that jumps and footing can't be gauged - BLIND	A pair (2) of game animals - BRACE
The animal being hunted - QUARRY	The face of the fox - MASK
The fox's foot - PAD	What you say when you see a (view) a fox - TALLY HO
What you say when you pass a hole to warn other riders – WARE HOLE	What someone says when they want you to be quiet and listen – HARK
What you will hear when a staff rider wants you to step aside - STAFF PLEASE	What the MFH or staff will say when a fox is viewed (seen) - HALLOO
Less experienced riders, may go around obstacles, may be riding, or on foot, or in cars. HILLTOPPERS	The fox's scent trail - LINE
Woodland or thicket where the quarry may lie for shelter - COVERT	A donation or fee on the day of the hunt meet towards the upkeep of the hounds. CAPPING FEE

<p>A canine NOT from the pack - CUR DOG</p>	<p>The cry of the hounds when in full hunt - MUSIC</p>
<p>To see a fox - "VIEW" (after answer can explain "It was good hunting today. We <i>viewed</i> twice")</p>	<p>What to say when a hound gets separated from the pack is trying to get through the field of riders – "WARE HOUND"</p>
<p>A nickname for a fox - UNCLE REMUS</p>	<p>A group of foxes - SKULK</p>
