

“Kit? What Kit?” Stations Simulation

This is a Stations Phase simulation. The participants will need to match up a set of items cards with a set of rally kit cards. For example, there is a card reading “Screwdriver” and a card reading “Utility Kit”; they need to match these two cards together.

The quiz members compete in the stations phase as a team. They approach the table as a team, they are allowed to discuss the answers, and they usually are allowed to touch the items on the table.

Print pages 4, 5, 6 (the item cards) on card or cover stock paper. Print pages 7 & 8 (the Kit cards) on card or cover stock paper. (a different color of paper would be helpful, but not necessary if you can print with colored ink. The item cards are in blue, the KIT cards are in red font.) Cut out the item cards and the kit cards.

Our club runs a ‘mock’ rally right before the actual quiz rally. This is an example of one of our stations phases. Because we might have parent volunteers who are not familiar with how quiz is organized, the next page is the instructions for the parent who is running the “mock” stations table.



Kit? What Kit? Stations Simulation

Object of Station: Correctly match the blue ITEM cards to the red KIT Card; to identify which items belong in each kit as identified on the Required Equipment List

Table Judge: Directions

1. Lay out red KIT cards, leaving enough room for the competitors to place blue item cards next to them.
2. Shuffle the blue ITEM cards. Place the stack of blue ITEM cards on the table (no need to spread them out)
3. Cover these cards with newspaper or in some way so the approaching team cannot read ahead.
4. When the team approaches, read the following rules;
 - a. Work as a team, find a way to divide up the task to save time. Check your answers.
 - b. You may discuss, but not so loudly that you give away the answers to other surrounding teams.
 - c. You may touch the cards.
 - d. Place the orange ITEM with the correct Green Required Equipment KIT card.
 - e. You will have 5 minutes for this station.
 - f. If you finish before the time limit the team captain must announce that to me.
 - g. Your team will receive 1 point for each correct match. Possible points = 25
 - h. Your time begins now
5. Remove the covering and begin timing.
6. After 5 minutes tell the team to stop.
7. Check the team's matches to your answer sheet.
8. Tell the team their score AND write this on the table/team score sheet.
9. They must wait at your station until told to move to the next station.
