Top 10 Rules at Quiz for Parents, Siblings & Spectators

- 10. No coaching Competitors during breaks.
- 9. Remind Competitors ahead of time to use restrooms before competition begins and between Phases.
- 8. No spectators will be allowed in testing areas during competition.
- 7. Please do not communicate in any way with Competitors during any phase of the testing. You may not talk to a Competitor once a Phase has begun nor during the 30-minute inquiry/protest period at the end of each phase unless the competitor/team has signed off on the phase nor during the 30-minute inquiry/protest period when final scores are posted. Unauthorized assistance will result in your expulsion from the area and may result in penalty points or expulsion for the Competitor and/or the Competitor's entire team.
- 6. You may not attempt to influence or interfere with a Judge's decision or with the process of inquiry or protest.
- 5. Please stay in the designated areas for parents/spectators. Going in to competition areas may risk unauthorized assistance penalties for the competitors.
- 4. Bring something to occupy your time while you wait for your child. It can be a long day.
- 3. Questions about scoring may be made ONLY by the team captain; parents or other non-competing visitors are not allowed to inquire about the scores!
- 2. Keep non-competing siblings under your care and control at all times.
- 1. Regardless of the score or placing, your child learned about horses, competing, and teamwork. Please encourage your child to appreciation each success and learn from each stumble. ENJOY! HAVE FUN! GOOD LUCK!
