Stiff brush used to remove heavy dirt/sweat - DANDY BRUSH	Good for removing stains, rubbing out sweat marks, and giving final polish after grooming - RUB RAG
Shorter, softer bristles used to remove dust and scruff, and adds shine to the coat. - BODY BRUSH	Used to clean the mounts eyes, nose, and dock. Must be marked and separate for each horse. -SPONGES/WET WIPES
Pulls extra water off a wet horse, speeds drying/cooling time -SCRAPER	Used to keep boots in shape when not being wore. Must include toes. - BOOT TREES
Used to identify the horse, his care, and contact information. Hung close to the mount. - STALL CARD	Hung outside the tack room identifying the competitor's names and numbers, their club, and their region. - TEAM ID
Hung in the feed room identifying the feeding instructions for each mount - FEED CHART	Required at overnight rallies - must be at least 5 gallons and placed outside the stall in the evening. - TOP-OFF BUCKET
The period of time a product can be stored and remain suitable for use. - SHELF LIFE	Used on horses after exercise to combat pain and swelling. Also used in hot weather to speed cooling - LINIMENT

Used to clean and disinfect items like scissors and thermometers - RUBBING ALCOHOL	Used when building a bandage over a bleeding or oozing wound - ABSORBENT COTTON
Used to cut a bandage off a mount. Has blunt tip. - BANDAGE SCISSORS	Need 3 pairs, can be latex, vinyl or other synthetic material - PROTECTIVE GLOVES
Used to protect human skin from ultraviolet sun rays - SUNSCREEN	Used to light the tack room in the dark - must have working batteries - FLASHLIGHT
Must be class 'A' or 'ABC'; Must be charged; must be easy to reach for all team members - FIRE EXTINGUISHER	Where the fire extinguisher and flashlight must be placed in the tack room - HUNG BY THE DOOR
Used to post ride times, and/or other important notices for the team members - NOTICE BOARD	Must be in the tack room - used to look up the horse management rules - HM RULEBOOK
Used to help pull on boots - BOOT HOOKS	Used to help take off boots - BOOT JACK

<p>Basic hardware tool - can be either flathead or phillips head - SCREWDRIVER</p>	<p>Basic hardware tool - used for grasping and turning bolts. - PLIERS</p>
<p>Used to cup ropes and ties in an emergency - must be sharp and sturdy. JACKKNIFE</p>	<p>Used to last minute tack adjustments. - LEATHER PUNCH</p>
<p>Used for the 2nd step of tack cleaning (conditioning) - OIL OR CONDITIONER</p>	<p>Used to clean any tack metal that DOES NOT come in contact with the horse's mouth - METAL POLISH</p>
<p>Used to hang tack while cleaning it - CLEANING HOOK</p>	<p>Used to dry sponges and wet cloths - DRYING BASKET</p>
<p>Used to apply tack cleaners, conditioners, and protectors - TACK SPONGES</p>	<p>(super-bonus question – get to mark all four!) These four items are needed in the tack room as extra tack in case a team member breaks theirs - BRIDLE, GIRTH, PEACOCK IRONS, LEATHERS</p>
