Instructions: Loading and Unloading a Horse Cards

Below are several pages of steps for how to load and unload a horse. The steps for loading a horse are in green ink and unloading steps are in red ink. Print out one copy of these pages for each student in your study group. Print on heavy paper (card or cover stock). White paper is best as there are photos on the pages which probably won't show up very well on colored paper.

For each set, cut the steps into strips such that each step is on a separate card. Mix them up and have each student put the steps in order.

This exercise should be done after you have reviewed the steps using the Loading/Unloading worksheets.

Answer Key:

LOADING:

- 1) Load your tack, supplies, and hang hay net. Get treat ready
- 2) Open front exit door
- 3) Load Horse
- 4) Put up butt bar
- 5) Close/raise back door
- 6) Tie Horse to front ring

UNLOADING:

- 1) Untie horse from front ring
- 2) Open/lower back door
- 3) lower butt bar
- 4) Lead horse out
- 5) Unload your tack and supplies
