






# Basic Safety Rules for Beginning Riders

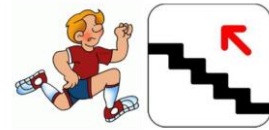

What	Why	
<p><b>Dress Safely</b></p>	<p>Wearing the wrong clothes can hurt you.</p>	 <p>+ LE</p>
<p>Ride with someone <b>Watching</b>, in enclosed ring, until instructor says otherwise</p>	<p>So they can get help if needed. NEVER RIDE ALONE.</p>	
<p>Ride a mount that is <b>suitable</b> for you</p>	<p>Otherwise you are putting yourself and others in danger</p>	
<p><b>Check</b> your <b>tack</b>, both sides, before mounting.</p>	<p>To avoid surprises</p>	 <p>-S</p>
<p>Keep a <b>safe distance</b> from other riders</p>	<p>At least 1 horse length</p>	

Runup your stirrups  
when unmounted

pony - he is your  
partner.

You horse counts on
