

## **The FIVE Steps of SHOEING**



Name:

1. What is the difference between a FARRIER and a BLACKSMITH?



A **Farrier** is a hoof care specialist.

A **Blacksmith** does all kinds of iron work, not just horseshoes.



2. What is **HOT** shoeing?

Using a hot forge to heat the iron and make or modify the shoes. The hot horseshoe is pressed against the bottom of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and leaves a mark. This mark tells the farrier if the shoe is the right \_\_\_\_\_\_ and if the hoof is level.

- a. Does it hurt the horse?
- b. Why would you ask for hot shoeing?

Because pre-made shoes don't your horse or your horse needs special shoes
